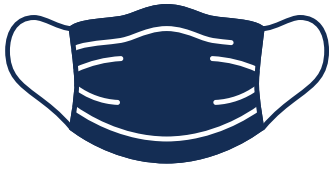


Visitor Policy







RED STATUS



Visitors must:

- Pass a health screening
- Wear medical-grade mask over mouth and nose at all times

» We will supply a mask if you do not have one

 Hospital	No visitors	No visitors
 Birth Center	One visitor* Plus one certified doula during labor and delivery	One visitor*
 Cancer Center (without hospital stay)	One visitor	One visitor
 Appointment and Procedure (without hospital stay)	One visitor	One visitor

*Patient may choose one visitor 18 years of age or older. Visitor must be the same individual throughout the patient's stay.

Exceptions May Include:

- Patients with disabilities or who are minors, regardless of COVID-19 status; end-of-life decisions and care; and other limited situations.

General Guidelines:

- Visitors should remain in the patient's room with their masks on.
- For your safety, visitors must be 18 years of age or older.
