 Emergency Department	Two visitors
 Hospital Visiting Hours: 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.	Four visitors <i>at the same time</i> *
 Intensive Care Unit Visiting Hours: 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.	Two visitors <i>at the same time</i> *
 Birth Center	Labor and delivery: Two designated visitors <i>at the same time</i> plus one certified doula* After delivery: Five designated visitors <i>at the same time</i> * Visitors must be 18 or older
 Cancer Center (without hospital stay)	Visitor number not restricted
 Appointment and Procedure (without hospital stay)	Visitor number not restricted
 Walk-In Care	Visitor number not restricted

*Guidelines for visiting a patient in isolation:

- Limit of two visitors at the same time. Follow other designated visitor guidelines above.
- Visitors should go directly to the patient's room and remain in the room during the visit, except to use the public restroom.
- For everyone's safety, visitors must wear personal protective equipment (PPE) and follow all instructions provided.

General guidelines:

- Visitors must pass a health screening.
- Visitors under 18 years of age must be supervised at all times by an adult. For patients in the emergency department or hospital, the adult cannot be the patient.

Exceptions may include:

- Patients with disabilities or who are minors; end-of-life decisions and care; other limited situations.
